REAL PEOPLE REAL LIVES is a resource pack developed to challenge the misconceptions held about disabled people and to promote inclusion in Key Stage 2 and 3 as part of the Personal, Health and Social Education Curriculum. The pack could also be used in any settings that involve young people or training for diversity.

## The pack consists of:

- Teachers' notes Lesson activities 20 coloured cards of disabled people carrying out everyday activities
- 5 coloured posters CD-ROM which contains a text file of the document and all the images.

The pack has been written by Michelle Daley, Assistant Training Co-ordinator at Disability Equality in Education. Funded by Newham Primary Care Trust, the pack is a starting point for getting young people to understand that inclusion is a basic human rights issue.
