The pack consists of:

- **Teachers' notes • Lesson activities • 20 coloured cards of disabled people carrying out everyday activities**
- **5 coloured posters • CD-ROM which contains a text file of the document and all the images.**

The pack has been written by Michelle Daley, Assistant Training Co-ordinator at Disability Equality in Education. Funded by Newham Primary Care Trust, the pack is a starting point for getting young people to understand that inclusion is a basic human rights issue.
